The idea is to solve environmental problems and research environmental issues by fostering multidisciplinary education and thinking.

As the global aspects of human actions and environmental problems such as the sustainability of big cities become more important, we specifically address international students. The difference in experience and background of the students is seen as a resource for enhanced understanding and vital discussions in this program.

The summer program includes lectures and workshops in the mornings, time for self-study and presentations in the afternoons as well as visits and exursions. Most evenings are free, giving you the chance to explore the summer in the beautiful metropolis which is situated in the Rhine River Valley.
